

Learner Outcomes for Sixth Year Classroom Teacher Specialist

At the end of this Sixth Year program as a Classroom Teacher Specialist, the learner will:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of the most current curriculum and learning theories and apply theory to practice in the classroom.
2. Demonstrate an understanding of the process of teaching and learning and its impact in the classroom
3. Develop and complete an applied field study project of interest to the students' area of specialization and/or grade level.
4. Demonstrate an understanding of the current issues that impact education and the mechanisms for making policy changes.

In addition based on which track the learner chooses for their electives the learner will:

1. Demonstrate a broader and more holistic approach to curriculum, assessment, teaching, parent involvement and/or classroom management, OR
2. Demonstrate extensive knowledge of a particular content area OR
3. Meet the state requirements for cross-endorsement.
