### **POLICY**

It is the policy of the clinical service programs of the Department of Communication Disorders (Center for Communication Disorders, Access Network, Southern Connecticut Audiology Services) that all clinical program activities occur under the administration of a Clinical Director.

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to provide a unified administrative structure within the clinical service programs of the Department of Communication Disorders to ensure quality speech-language pathology and audiology services and the achievement of the programs stated goals.

### **PROCEDURES**

1. The University allocates (or designates) a position of Clinical Director for the Department of Communication Disorders.
2. The qualifications for, and responsibilities of, the position of the Clinical Director are outlined (under position descriptions attached to Policy Number 040). Where applicable, all University and labor agreements take precedence.
