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### List of Nursing Pre-Reqs:

	<b>ENG 112</b> (need placement or ENG 110 first)
	<b>MAT 107</b> (need placement into or have MAT 100/P first; also, does not need to be completed before the MAT 108 requirement)
	<b>MAT 108</b> (need placement into or have taken MAT 100/P w/C- or higher first; also can be taken before MAT 107; other options: 112, 120, 122, 139, 150)
	<b>PSY 100</b> (must take before PSY 219)
	<b>PSY 219</b> (need PSY 100 first)
	<b>PHY 103</b> (need MAT 100 placement or have taken MAT 100/P first)
	<b>CHE 120</b> (need placement into at least MAT 108 or have MAT 100/P first; must take before CHE 125)
	<b>CHE 125</b> (not offered in fall; need CHE 120 first)
	<b>BIO 200</b> (must take before BIO 201)
	<b>BIO 201</b> (need BIO 200 first)
	<b>BIO 120</b>

\*Must complete at least 7 of these with a C+ or higher by the February 1<sup>st</sup> nursing application deadline.

\*\*All 11 must be complete with a C+ or higher by the start of the Nursing curriculum if admitted to the program.
