

Timeline for Pre-Nursing Students Applying to the BSN Program

Fall Semester: Year 1

- Become acclimated to college life.
- May be enrolled in a pre-req, but not always.
- Attend a group advisement session.
 - receive course information to register for the spring
 - receive information on nursing application eligibility
 - receive a brief explanation about the nursing application and deadlines
 - review resources that are available to students

Spring Semester: Year 1

- Should be enrolled in 3-4 nursing pre-reqs and university req(s).
- Will explore additional options in advisement workshop.
- Will be advised individually.
 - receive course information to register for the fall
 - receive information on what to expect after this semester
 - discuss questions/concerns
 - discuss summer course options if necessary
 - discuss studying for the TEAS

Summer: Year 1

- May want to begin studying for the TEAS.
- If applying to multiple nursing programs is an interest, students should begin researching other nursing program requirements and deadlines.

Timeline for Pre-Nursing Students Applying to the BSN Program

Fall Semester: Year 2

Those under a 3.0 at this point, would be advised for alternate major for spring courses

Those at a 3.0 or higher continue to follow the pre-nursing path...

Advisement/Academics

- Those at a 3.0 or higher will attend a nursing application information session in place of their advisement requirement. Info will include TEAS updates.
- Should be enrolled in 3-4 pre-reqs (should have at least 7 complete with a C+ or higher by the end of this semester) and university req(s).

Application

- Register for their TEAS exam (see pre-nursing website for details).
- Students may begin their nursing application (opens Nov. 1st).

Spring Semester: Year 2

Advisement/Academics

- Should have alternate major in mind and finalized by end of February.
- Those accepted to nursing are assigned a nursing faculty advisor and will meet with that advisor for fall semester course information.
- Those not accepted will carry out their alternate plan and will receive advisement from their new major department for fall semester course information.

Application

- Should take TEAS exam if haven't already (no later than the end of January).
- Should complete nursing application (to be submitted by Feb. 1st).
- Should apply or have applied to other nursing programs if desired.
- Should be enrolled in remaining pre-reqs and university req(s).
- Nursing admission letters will be received around spring break (mid-March) and no later than April 1st.

Summer: Year 2

- Students accepted to the nursing program who have outstanding pre-reqs will need to complete them at this time.
- Students accepted to the nursing program will have some items to complete during this summer.
